

Norms for payment of membership fee for faculty members of Engineering Colleges in Professional Bodies

Introduction

The objective of the scheme is to provide membership fee for faculty members of Engineering Colleges in Professional Bodies.

Eligibility (who can apply)

Any faculty member who is currently working in Government Engineering Colleges in Kerala having any two (a - e) of the following norms can apply for membership fee.

Guidelines

The application in the prescribed format should be submitted in duplicate to the Director, CERD, College of Engineering Trivandrum campus, Thiruvananthapuram. Pin 695 016

Rules

1. These rules may be called the 'Rules for payment of membership fee for professional body'.
2. Under these rules Financial assistance may be granted to the faculty members who are working in Government Engineering Colleges in Kerala, who have actively participated in the activities of the professional body by way of
 - a. Organizing Seminars/ Conferences in association with professional bodies.
 - b. Office bearers of the Professional bodies.
 - c. Attending Conferences/Seminars/ Workshops organized by the professional body.
 - d. Maintaining the membership for the last 2 consecutive years.
 - e. Member in Technical Committee constituted by the professional body.
 - f. The applicant should have at least one sponsored project funded by External Agencies other than CERD. **(Mandatory)**
 - g. Maximum 50% of the membership fee will be reimbursed for those who are meeting minimum any two of the above criteria limited to Rs.2000/-.
 - h. Membership in minimum 2 professional bodies can be admitted with the above norms.
 - i. This is applicable only for professional bodies wherein annual membership fee has to be paid.
 - j. Only reimbursement will be made against original bills.
